FINAL INSTRUCTIONS No.1

- Thank you for your entry. Your Competition Number is detailed on the club website – www.omaghmotorclub.co.uk – and on the club's Facebook page. Competitors should ensure that they are entered in the correct class on the entry list. Failure to do this may result in you being excluded from the results at the end of the event.
- 2. Competition numbers, a Roadbook, Timecards and an Entry List will be supplied by the organisers in sealed folders and can be collected from Rally Office in the Service Park. Please ensure that you enter your competition number on each of the Timecards when you open this pack. Please ensure that you clearly fill in the relevant Arrival times, Stage Start times and Stage Finish times and show your timecard to an official before leaving any control. The Rally Office will be open from 6pm to 9pm on Friday evening and from 7am on Saturday morning.
- 3. Competitors are reminded that they must have their competition licences and membership cards available for inspection upon request. No licence application will be permitted on the day. Any non-production of a licence must be accompanied by an email from Motorsport UK or MSI and will be referred to the Motorsport UK Steward of the event.
- 4. Pre-event documentation and any instructions issued during the event will be available on the Sportity App which can be downloaded free of charge. The password for the event is Bushwhacker21.
- 5. The Supplementary Regulations for the event are amended as follows; Event Summary Information: Rally HQ Replace "Silverbirch Hotel" with "Omagh Showgrounds".
 - SR.5 The event is no longer a round of the McGrady Insurance ANICC Forest Rally Challenge.
 - SR.10 Restart After Retirement Replace "if they confirm in writing their intention to the Clerk of the Course" by "if they confirm their intention to the Competitor Liaison Officer"
 - SR.12 Awards There will be no formal prizegiving. Awards will be posted to crews after the event.
 - SR.14 The Chief Medical Officer is now Tony Chisholm.
 - SR.16 Results will be available on www.rallyscore.net and on the Sportity App.

- 6. Start Times will be displayed at the Start Control and on the Sportity App.
- 7. There will be no formal Scrutiny, however a sample of cars will be examined for compliance with, noise, tyre and vehicle regulations as well as class eligibility, and spot checks will be carried out throughout the event. All competitors are reminded that they must be able to produce; a Vehicle Registration document, a Motorsport UK/MI Vehicle Passport /Log Book, and a current MOT/NCT certificate where applicable. Vehicles registered outside the UK are subject to the MOT regulations that apply in their country of origin. Paper copies of MOT certificates and Car Tax must be available for inspection by the Scrutineers. Electronic copies of these documents produced on a phone or other electronic device are not acceptable. Helmets, Clothing and Frontal Head Restraints must be produced for inspection on request.
- 8. The Service Park is in the Showgrounds Complex, Drumquin Road, Omagh. The Service Park opens at 6.30am and all vehicles must be in place by 8.30am. Only one Service vehicle will be admitted to the Service Park. Service vehicles should be spaced in the paddock in a manner that social distancing can be observed. Please obey the instructions of the marshals. All crews must use ground sheets and keep their location tidy and clear of rubbish at all times.
- 9. A Trailer Park is available in the adjacent Farmer's Mart and all trailers must be parked at this location. Access to the Trailer Park is from the Service Park at the rear of Rally HQ. Only this route must be used. Access is not permitted from the main Farmer's Mart entrance or from any other access gate within the Service Park.
- 10. Smoking is not permitted in the Service Park and open refuelling using a funnel or suchlike is not permitted. Cars must be refuelled using a hand pump or have a proper pourer attached to a Jerry Can.
- 11. Please read the event Covid-19 protocol and be aware of the procedures in relation to stopping on a stage. Competitors must have a face mask available in their car or on their person when competing on a stage. This is to facilitate vehicle recovery. Face masks, gloves and hand sanitiser must be available for all team personnel. Competitors are reminded that any abuse of Covid-19 precautions may result in your disqualification from the event.
- 12. Please ensure that you are familiar with the SOS/OK procedure which is detailed in the front of the Roadbook.
- 13. If you retire from the event please have your timecards ready for collection by the Tailsweep car. Delaying the Tailsweep car while you look for your timecards can cause a delay in the rally time schedule.

- 14. Competitors who retire from the event on Special Stages 1-3 will have the opportunity to have further competition providing they confirm their intention to the Competitor Liaison Officer thirty minutes prior to the first car due time of the subsequent section (Service Out Control prior to Special Stage 4). Vehicles MUST be re-scrutineered and this scrutineering will take place in the event Service Park. Timecards will be issued by the Competitor Relations Officer upon completion of re-scrutiny. Competitors will be re-seeded at the Clerk of the Course's discretion.
- 15. Food will be available from on-site catering
- 16. The Competitor Liaison Officer is Gary Milligan who will be available at the Start, Service In Controls and the Finish. Please direct all queries to him by Telephone, Text or WhatsApp.
